

## CALL FOR WORKSHOP PROPOSALS

The organizing committee of ACPR 2021 invites researchers in pattern recognition, computer vision, and machine learning to submit workshop proposals. We are soliciting proposals for a workshop to be held in conjunction with ACPR 2021.

The workshop will be held on the first and last day of the main conference (November 9 & 12) in the same location as the main conference. The purpose of the workshop is to encourage in-depth, lively, and interactive forum for the discussion on the latest technological and applied research topics not covered in detail in the main conference.

Workshop proposals are welcome in all areas of pattern recognition, computer vision, machine learning and applications. Workshop organizers are encouraged to submit specific, actionable, and relevant proposals to the ACPR 2021. For very similar workshop proposals, we may ask the organizers to merge them into a single workshop.

### Important Dates

Workshop Proposal Deadline: **August 15, 2021**

### Suggestion format

Workshop organizers must submit workshop proposals by August 15, 2021. Each workshop proposal is limited to 2-3 pages and must include:

- Title of workshop.
- Description of the technical issues covered, emphasizing the timeliness of the proposed workshop.
- Workshop organizers (names, affiliation and contact information).
- Expected number of participants and potential program committee members.
- Description of the publicity plan on how to attract participants and submissions.
- Planned format: participant selection, timeline, type of contributions, discussions and integration of non-presenting participants:
  - Duration of the workshop: Half-day, Full-day and tentative schedule.
  - Number of refereed papers, hot topic sessions, keynotes, panels (and panel formats), etc.
  - Plan for the review of the refereed papers
- A draft workshop call for papers with the names, affiliations, addresses, phone numbers and email addresses of the workshop organizers.
- Draft call for papers
- A description of the publicity and promotion plan.
- The workshop potential website address (if available at the time of the proposal - will be

required later if the workshop proposal is accepted).

- If appropriate, a description of past versions of the workshop, including number of submitted and accepted papers, number of attendees, etc.

Proposals should be submitted via email to the workshop chairs.

### **Workshop Proceedings**

– There are no plans to publish proceedings through a publisher. To increase visibility, however, accepted papers should be posted on the workshop website and will also be posted on the main ACPR homepage (similar to workshops of recent major conferences).
